

DIRECTIONS TO KEY VEHICLE SOLUTIONS

Please note that the accompanying map is not to scale!



From the West / M62

Leave the **M62** at **junction 38** and turn left, following the signs for **North Cave**.

Go through the village of **North Cave** following the signs for **Beverley**. After approximately 8 miles you will arrive at the village of **Walkington** (lots of speed bumps and a village pond etc).

Stay on the main road through the village until you arrive at crossroads with traffic lights. Turn left and follow the road for approximately a mile until you arrive at a roundabout.

Take the second exit from the roundabout sign posted for **Leconfield**. Follow this road for approximately half a mile and you will come to another roundabout.

Take the first exit from this roundabout sign posted for **Scarborough and Malton**. After approximately a quarter of a mile you will arrive at crossroads. **Cherry Burton** is sign posted to the left and follow this road into the village.

Follow the road around the tight right hand bend and you will see the church on the left-hand side. When you see the church start to indicate to the left, as immediately past the entrance to the church yard is a gravel driveway. Turn up this drive and go through the second gateway – we are at the end of this drive on the right hand side.

N.B. This route is not suitable for HGV's. These vehicles should continue along the M62/A63 and then use the route from the South / Humber Bridge.

From the South / Humber Bridge

From the roundabout on the north side of the **Humber Bridge** take the **A164** sign posted to **Beverley**. Stay on this road for approximately 6 miles following the signs for **Beverley**.

BEFORE arriving at **Beverley** turn left onto the **A1079** sign posted for York. At the next roundabout take the third exit sign posted for **Leconfield**. Follow this road for approximately half a mile and you will come to another roundabout.

Take the first exit from this roundabout sign posted for **Scarborough and Malton**. After approximately a quarter of a mile you will arrive at crossroads. **Cherry Burton** is sign posted to the left and follow this road into the village.

Follow the road around the tight right hand bend and you will see the church on the left-hand side. When you see the church start to indicate to the left, as immediately past the entrance to the church yard is a gravel driveway. Turn up this drive and go through the second gateway – we are at the end of this drive on the right hand side.

From the North / York

Follow the **A1079** south from **York**. There are two turnings off the **A1079**, which lead directly into **Cherry Burton**. The first turning forks off to the left approximately 6 miles after **Market Weighton** (1 mile before the village of **Bishop Burton**). The second turning is off to the left at the crossroads immediately after the village of **Bishop Burton**. Both junctions are clearly sign posted for **Cherry Burton**.

Follow the road through the village of **Cherry Burton** until you see the Church on the right hand side. Immediately before the church, on the same side, is a gravel driveway – we are at the end of this drive on the right hand side.
